Amateur Radio Operators' Certificate (ASOC) Examination

General Guide lines

1. Any Indian citizen above 12 years of age can appear for only the Restricted Grade ASOC Examination.
2. Any Indian citizen above 18 years of age can appear for either the Restricted or the General Grade or both Grades of ASOC Examination.
3. The ASOC examination is conducted by Wireless Monitoring Stations, W. P. C. Wing, DOT, Ministry of Communication Technology, Govt. of India, at different locations, in different parts of India, several times per year.

The following documents must accompany the ASOC Examination application form:

1. An attested copy of birth certificate or school leaving certificate.
2. Certificate in support of nationality in the prescribed Performa, indicated in Appendix III.
3. 4 passport size photo graphs signed and named on back.
4. Four Copies of Personal Details of Applicant.
5. If the applicant is between 12 to 18 years of age, a No Objection Certificate from Parent / Guardian / Head of Institution is to be included. Applicants over 18 years of should submit a self attested photocopy of an identity proof and an address proof. (Aadhar / EPIC / Driving Licence / Passport).
6. Demand draft of ₹ 1080 drawn from any Nationalised Bank in favour of 'Amateur Radio Convention And Conference Samity' payable at Kolkata. This can also be paid by NEFT or IMPS in favour of 'Amateur Radio Convention And Conference Samity' in the Esplanade Branch of IDBI Bank Savings Account No. 1270104000026381; IFSC Code: IBKL0001270. This fee can also be paid by Debit Card / Credit Card / Netbanking / UPI at <http://imojo.in/asocexam> . This fee includes the WPC Wing Examination Fee.

The ASOC Examination is of Multiple Choice Objective Type.

Restricted Grade: 50 MCQ in 1 hour examination; **General Grade:** 100 MCQ in 2 hours examination.

Syllabus:

Restricted Grade: Basic Electronics, Rules & Regulations

General Grade: Basic Electronics, Rules & Regulations, Morse Code at 8 wpm.

If anyone has a Degree or Diploma in Electronics, then he/she will be exempted from Section A (Basic Electronics) of the exams, and will appear in Section B (Rules & Regulation) and Morse Code.

After about one month of the examinations, the results will be issued to the successful candidates. On receiving the result, an application letter (in prescribed format) must be sent to Ministry of Communications, Govt. of India, New Delhi for the issue of Amateur Radio Licence and Call Sign. The whole process takes several months.
